

30 Hours Funding Policy

Policy statement

Yateley Community preschool will be offering 30 hours free funding

30 hours free is for only **38 weeks** per year

Not everyone is eligible, but everyone **will** still receive the 15 hours free childcare that is currently available.

Eligibility rules for 30 hours free childcare:

- Your child will be aged 3 or 4 when the scheme starts in your area
- Both parents must be working – or the sole parent is working in a lone parent family
- Each parent earns, on average, a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at National Minimum Wage or National Living Wage
- Each parent must have an annual income of less than £100,000
- You live in England
- Codes must be submitted within the deadline, subject to application
- 30 Hours will be offered to our current parents first before offering out to new starters.
- Hours will be distributed on a first come first served basis
- The number of 30 hours funding places is subject to child numbers and is at the discretion of the committee.
- The committee reserve the right to withdraw the 30 hours funding if it is not financially viable for the preschool.

The 30 years funding will be looked at by the committee to see if it is still viable and workable financially.
